November 12, 1940

The meeting was called to order by President Rae Greene. Minutes for the meeting of November 5, were read and approved.

Ryan presented a revision of Article V of the by-laws. Bourke moved we accept the following revision of article V of the by-laws:

"The nomination of candidates for any vacancy of the class offices of president, vice-president, secretary or treasurer will be made from the floor providing that the qualifications set forth in Article VII, Section 11 of the Constitution have been expressly fulfilled; that each candidate nominated is present in person at the time of his nomination; and that at least 15% of the members of that class vote. Voting will be by secret ballot and the candidate receiving the largest number of votes shall duly fill the vacancy."

Price seconded it and the motion carried.

Haydon presented a tentative budget for the musical show. As yet, the show to be produced has not been chosen but several are being considered. Lester and Haydon have not decided whether two or three performances will be given. However, the budget was made out for three. Ways of obtaining the opinions of townspeople in order to estimate attendance were discussed. It was agreed to table this matter until such time as we know what play is going to be produced and a more definite budget is presented.

Barbara Adams was present to discuss the Sadie Hawkins' Day Dance, with service organizations doing the work. Fairbanks moved that A.S.M.S.U. sponsor a Sadie Hawkins' Day Dance with the understanding that the ex-Spurs assume responsibility for its promotion. Christenson seconded it and the Motion carried. Greene appointed Barbara Adams to take charge of the dance.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
