WATER POLLUTION CONTROL IS SUBJECT OF PUBLIC LECTURE FRIDAY AT UM

MISSOULA --

"Montana's Water Pollution Control Program" is the topic of a free public lecture to be given Friday at the University of Montana by Steven L. Pilcher, Helena, a specialist for the Water Quality Bureau, State Department of Health and Environmental Sciences.

Pilcher will deliver his lecture at noon Friday, April 23, in room 307, UM Natural Science Building.

His remarks will deal with various federal and state regulations and how the regulations affect the state's water pollution control program.
