MISSOULA--

A film in German entitled "Berlin--Alexanderplatz," a movie based on the 1929 novel of the same name by Alfred Doblin (pronounced Dubleen) will be presented at 7:30 p.m. Thursday, May 20, in room 207 of the University of Montana Liberal Arts Building.

Thursday's film presentation is open to the public without charge under the sponsorship of the UM Department of Foreign Languages. The movie, set in the Berlin of the 1920s, was filmed in 1931 and does not have English subtitles.

Dr. Dennis R. McCormick, assistant professor of foreign languages at UM, who is coordinator of the film presentation, said Thursday's movie "is strongly indebted to the silent film style."
