8TH KYI-YO INDIAN YOUTH CONFERENCE IS THURSDAY-SATURDAY AT UNIVERSITY

MISSOULA --

The 8th Annual Kyi-Yo Indian Youth Conference will be Thursday through Saturday, May 20-22, at the University of Montana in Missoula. Representatives of Montana's seven Indian reservations will participate in the conference, which is sponsored by the UM Kyi-Yo Indian Club.

Theme of the conference is "1776-1976: Two Hundred Years of Resistance."

Conference registration will be at 7 p.m. Wednesday, May 19, at the UM Native American Studies Building, 730 Eddy Ave., and from 8 a.m.-noon Thursday, May 20, in the Harry Adams Field House. Conference registration fees are \$4 for high school and college students and \$5 for the general public.

Lectures during the conference, and powwows scheduled for 7 p.m. Friday and Saturday in the field house will be open to the public without charge. All conference events are free to UM students.

The Miss Kyi-Yo Indian Youth Pageant will be at 6 p.m. Thursday in the field house and a concert featuring Paul Ortega and Gen Huitt will be at 5 p.m. Saturday there.

Admission to Thursday's Miss Kyi-Yo Indian Youth Pageant will be \$2 and admission to Saturday's concert will be \$3 for the general public.
