October 3, 1939

The meeting was called to order by President Pantzer. The minutes of the meeting of June 1 were read and approved.

President Pantzer informed the board that the "M" Book cast had been cut down and that it had not had the leatherette cover as previously planned.

President Pantzer read a letter from Herb Lang, Chairman of the Outside Entertainment Committee, informing the board of the resignation of Professor H.G. Merriam from the Outside Entertainment Committee, and recommending Dean Crowder of the Music School to fill the vacancy. Walter Elliot made a motion that Dean Crowder be named Faculty Advisor to the Outside Entertainment Committee to replace Professor H.G. Merriam. Carter Williams seconded the motion and it was carried.

The possibility of combining the Armistice Day Parade with the Homecoming Parade was discussed and it was decided to leave the matter to Rae Greene, Chairman of the Homecoming Committee.

Carter Williams made a motion that Central Board approve an appropriation to the band to be taken from the Travel Fund to provide one-half the transportation expenses to the Butte game providing that that amount does not exceed \$125. Rae Greene seconded and the motion was carried.

A motion was made, seconded, and carried for adjournment.
