CHARLES HOREJSI TO LECTURE AT CHICAGO MEETING

Dr. Charles Horejsi, associate professor of social work at the University of Montana in Missoula, will present a special Centennial lecture on social work practice in the field of mental retardation at the 100th annual meeting of the American Association on Mental Deficiency Sunday through Friday, May 30-June 4, in Chicago, Ill.
