FREY, ZYLAWY TO ASSIST IN TRANSLATION  
OF BOOK ENTITLED 'THE GODS ARE ATHIRST'

Dr. Linda S. Frey, assistant professor of history at the University of Montana, and Dr. Roman I. Zylawy, assistant professor of foreign languages at UM, will assist in translating a book dealing with the French Revolution from French into English. The Book, written by 19th century author Anatole-France, is entitled "The Gods Are Athirst."

Frey and Zylawy, along with Frey's sister, Dr. Marsha Frey, an assistant professor of foreign languages at Kansas State University, Manhattan, have received a contract for the project from Norwood Editions, a publishing firm in Darby, Pa.

Zylawy said the English translation of "The Gods Are Athirst" will be about 300 pages in length. He said Dr. Marsha Frey felt there is a need for the book in French classes because it deals with the French Revolution.
