MANAGERIAL EFFECTIVENESS SEMINARS FOR WOMEN  
SCHEDULED IN MONTANA THIS SUMMER

MISSOULA--

Dr. Maureen F. Ullrich, assistant professor of management at the University of Montana in Missoula, will conduct four seminars this summer concerning managerial effectiveness for women.

Regular seminars will be offered June 16-18 at UM in Missoula and June 23-25 in Helena. Advanced seminars will be offered July 14-16 at UM and July 21-23 at Fairmont Hot Springs, east of Anaconda. Registration deadline is June 9.

Ullrich, who received her master of arts and doctor of philosophy degrees from Southern Illinois University, will be offering the seminars for the second year. About 100 women from throughout the state participated in the seminars last year.

Each seminar is a three-day professional workshop designed to help women increase their supervisory and managerial skills. The aspects of management to be discussed include: management theory, supervisory skills, career goals and selected approaches for handling situations unique to women in management.

Cost of attending one of the seminars is \$200, which includes materials, supplies and a participant's kit. Interested women should send a \$50 pre-registration fee and indication of which seminar they will be attending to the Center for Continuing Education and Summer Programs, Room 107, University Hall, University of Montana, Missoula, Mont. 59801.
