October 31, 1939

The meeting was called to order by President Pantzer. The minutes of the meeting of Oct. 24 were read and approved.

Sally Hopkins made a motion that Central Board approve the recommendations of Publications Board that William Nash be appointed editor, John Kujich, business manager, and R.L. Houseman faculty advisor for the Sluice Box for the year 1939-40. Walter Elliot seconded the motion and it was carried.

Sally Hopkins made a motion that Central Board approve the appointments of the following as a committee to revise the By-Laws:

And one other to be selected by the President. Marcus Bourke seconded the motion and it was carried.

Carter Williams made a motion that Central Board approve President Pantzer's action in writing letters to the heads of various committees asking them to send in quarterly reports. Sally Hopkins seconded and the motion was carried.

A motion was made, seconded, and carried for adjournment.
