60 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS PREREGISTER
FOR SECOND WEEK OF CHAMBER MUSIC WORKSHOP

MISSOULA--

A total of 60 high school students from various Montana communities have preregistered for the second segment of the University of Montana Chamber Music Workshop, scheduled for June 20-27 on the Missoula campus.

Workshop sessions will include vocal and piano rehearsals and several recitals and concerts.

Vocal portions of the eight-day program will be conducted by Dr. Donald W. Simmons, chairman of the UM Department of music, and Esther England, assistant professor of music at UM. J. George Hummel, a UM music professor, will be in charge of piano rehearsals.

Free public recitals are scheduled Tuesday and Thursday, June 22 and June 24, in conjunction with the music workshop.

A vocal quartet consisting of University faculty members will present one of the recitals at 8 p.m. Tuesday, June 22, in the UM Music Recital Hall. Members of the quartet include England; Priscilla Chadduck, assistant professor; George D. Lewis, professor, and Patrick Williams, assistant professor.

Jenanne Solberg, Missoula, who received her bachelor's degree in music Sunday, June 13, at UM, will play the piano, and Mary Frances Lewis, a UM music student from Missoula, will be organist during another free public recital at 8 p.m. Thursday, June 24, in the UM Music Recital Hall.

The public also is invited to attend free public workshop concerts at 11 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. Sunday, June 27, in the UM Music Recital Hall. The concerts will feature the

high school students participating in the second week of the UM Chamber Music Workshop.

Sponsors of the Chamber Music Workshop at UM are the UM School of Fine Arts and Department of Music. William Manning, professor of music at UM, is workshop director.

Workshop sessions conducted at UM this week are featuring a number of chamber music ensembles, including string, brass and woodwind groups.
