JAMES C. HALL OF CHICAGO APPOINTED
TO DEAN'S POST AT UNIVERSITY OF MONTANA

MISSOULA, Mont.--

Dr. James C. Hall, Chicago, Ill., has been appointed dean of the Center for Continuing Education and Summer Programs (CCESP) at the University of Montana (UM) in Missoula, UM President Richard C. Bowers has announced. The appointment is effective July 1.

In the Montana post, Hall, who has been dean of the College of Continuing Education since May 1975 at Roosevelt University, Chicago, will assume the directorship duties of Dr. Patricia P. Douglas, assistant to the president, who has served as CCESP director since September 1972. Douglas will continue to serve as Bowers' assistant.

Hall's duties at UM will include coordination of on-campus and off-campus extension classes; summer programs; Upward Bound/Special Services activities, and study abroad programs involving UM students and faculty.

Included in the University-related functions coming under Hall's supervision are the associate of arts degree programs for officers and prisoners at the Montana State Prison, Deer Lodge.

Hall received a bachelor of arts degree in English in June 1965 at Marquette University, Milwaukee, Wis., and he was awarded the master of arts degree in adult education in September 1967 and the doctor of philosophy degree in adult and higher education in June 1975 at the University of Chicago, Chicago.

Before his appointment as dean of the Roosevelt University College of Continuing Education, Hall served as acting dean of the college from September 1971 to April 1975. He was assistant dean of the college from 1969-1971.

From 1965-66 and 1967-69, Hall was a research assistant in the University of Chicago Department of Education. Hall served as an administrative assistant in the Division of Continuing Education at Marquette University from 1962-65, and he was a Kellogg Fellow in the University of Chicago Center for Continuing Education from 1966-67.
