A divorce-related assertiveness workshop for women will be conducted Saturday, /31, in Missoula under the sponsorship of the University of Montana Women's Resource Center (WRC).

The workshop will be from 9:30 a.m. to noon and 1 to 4 p.m. July 31 in the Missoula City-County Library conference room. Registration, set for 9 a.m. July 31, will be \$5 for each participant.

The workshop, designed for women who are already divorced or who are in various stages of divorce, will be led by members of the Montana Assertiveness Training Collective for Women, a group of Missoula women trained in teaching assertiveness.
