MISSOULA--

A total of 1,981 students at the University of Montana, Missoula, received degrees during the 79th Annual UM Commencement exercises recently in the Harry Adams Field House at UM.

Names of 346 of the graduates were released during the fall of 1975, following the completion of the 1975 UM Summer Session.

A breakdown by degrees for the recent commencement shows that 46 received doctoral degrees, 65 were awarded juris doctor (law) degrees, 354 received master's degrees, 1,501 were awarded bachelor's degrees and 15 received associate of arts degrees.

A listing of fall, winter and spring graduates follows. Names are listed by degree, then alphabetically by hometowns, with in-state graduates followed by graduates from out-of-state communities and those from other countries.
