Mary Helen Richards, director of the Richards Institute of Music Education and Research in Portola Valley, Calif., will conduct a workshop entitled "Education Through Music" Aug. 16-20 in Deer Lodge under the sponsorship of the University of Montana Center for Continuing Education and Summer Programs (CCESP).

The course, offered for two graduate or undergraduate credits by the CCESP at a cost of \$42, is designed for Montana music teachers and elementary and special education instructors. The five-day program utilizes music to aid in developing language and motor skills in children.

The intensive workshop will begin with registration at 8 a.m. Monday, Aug. 16, at the Granville Stuart School, Deer Lodge. Total cost will be \$42.

Richards, who also is director of the Richards Institute in Chatham, Ont., is presenting a number of "Education Through Music" workshops in Canada and the U.S. this summer.
