KATHY ROEMER TO BE FEATURED SOLOIST
AT WEDNESDAY'S MISSOULA CITY BAND CONCERT;
EDD BLACKLER TO DO SONG BY LOCAL COMPOSERS

MISSOULA--

Mezzo-soprano Kathy Roemer, Missoula, a former University of Montana student, will be featured soloist Wednesday, Aug. 11, at the Missoula City Band Concert. The concert, which is open to the public without charge, will be at 8 p.m. Wednesday at Bonner Park.

Alex Stepanzoff, chairman of the UM Executive Board, is band director.

Roemer, who has played in the City Band's trumpet section several years, will sing "Londonderry Air," an old Irish melody featuring an arrangement by M. L. Lake, and "Moon River," with words by Johnny Mercer and music by Henry Mancini.

Also appearing as a soloist during Wednesday's concert will be Edd Blackler, Missoula, who will complete the requirements for his bachelor of arts degree in education with a major in music Aug. 20 at UM. Blackler will sing an original work entitled "Old Montana," featuring lyrics by John T. Campbell, Missoula, and music by Betty J. Crowley, also of Missoula.

Blackler, who sang with the UM Opera Workshop and University Jubileers from 1964-68 and who has performed at the Bigfork Summer Theater, will teach choral music for grade schools and high schools in Eureka, Fortine and Trego beginning this fall.
