MISSOULA--

Persons who plan to donate blood during a two-day Red Cross drawing at the University of Montana are requested to give the blood Monday morning or afternoon or Tuesday morning in order to minimize the chances of conflicting with a Tuesday afternoon University Center course.

The blood drawing will be from 10:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m. Monday and Tuesday in the University Center Ballroom.

Mrs. Harriet Veazey, Missoula, executive director of the area Red Cross chapter, said a UC course is scheduled to begin after 5 p.m. Tuesday, so blood donor volunteers will not be accepted after 3:30 p.m. Tuesday.

Women students from UM who will be assisting in the Monday-Tuesday blood drawing will be from the Alpha Omicron Pi social sorority. The Kappa Kappa Gamma social sorority members, originally scheduled to assist, will be unable to assist in the drawing because of illness.

A total of 300 units of blood are sought in the two-day University drawing.
