October 5, 1938

The meeting was called to order by President John Hanrahan. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Bob Pantzer made a motion that the Masquers' debt of \$280 to the Student Union retirement fund be paid out of the Masquers' reserve fund. Chumrau seconded the motion. The motion was carried.

Peter Murphy reported that the Homecoming committee is planning to send out letters to the alumni to encourage them to attend the Homecoming. It was suggested that these letters be inserted into the alumni publication which the University is sending out. He also said that the committee would ask the fraternity and sorority houses to decorate. It was decided that it should be left up to the houses whether these decorations should be on a competitive basis.

Bill Giltner has asked Central Board for \$12 for cuts of students for the publicity department. Kirk suggested that this amount might be taken out of the budgeted allowance for miscellaneous expenditure.

Paul Chumrau reported that Mr. Bell wants to take the entire band to the Gonzaga game. The cost would be \$480. Shallenberger made a motion that Phil Peterson report at the next meeting on the attitude of Interfraternity and Panhellenic and as many of the organizations as possible regarding the sending of the band. Rae Greene seconded. The motion was carried.

The meeting was adjourned.
