GREG SCHMAUTZ AWARDED \$200  
SENTINEL KIWANIS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

MISSOULA--

Greg Schmautz, Missoula, a senior majoring in art and geography at the University of Montana, was recently awarded a \$200 scholarship by the Sentinel Kiwanis Club of Missoula.

The scholarship is awarded annually to a UM upper-class student who is a graduate of one of the three local high schools. Schmautz was selected as this year's scholarship recipient out of 21 UM students who applied for the award.

Schmautz, a 1971 graduate of Sentinel High School, was chosen unanimously to receive the award by a committee composed of students, UM faculty and staff, and Kiwanis Club members. Selection criteria for the award is based on grade point average, need, and on-campus and off-campus activities.

Dr. Fred Weldon, director of the UM Center for Student Development, who is a Kiwanis Club member, is in charge of handling the scholarship details for the Sentinel Kiwanis Club and UM.
