November 8, 1938

The meeting was called to order by President John Hanrahan. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as corrected.

The report of the committee on the all school show was read. Chumrau made a motion that Central Board go on record as approving the edea of an all-school show without any promise of financial backing from A.S.M.S.U. Breen seconded. The motion was carried.

Breen reported that Mr. Bell wants to take the band to Butte for the Bobcat-Grizzly Game. Pantzer made a motion that Central Board authorize a committee to be appointed by the President to conduct a tag sale with the help of the band; and in case the necessary amount is not raised by the tag sale the difference will be loaned out of the travel fund to be paid back by the band at some future time to be arranged later. Chumrau seconded. The motion carried.

Hanrahan appointed Forbis, Pantzer, Greene, and Smith as a committee to work with Mr. Bell.

The meeting was adjourned.
