Applications for an assistant student lobbyist for the Montana Student Lobby (MSL), an organization which lobbies for student interests in the Montana Legislature, are available at the offices of the Associated Students of the University of Montana (ASUM). ASUM offices are located in room 105 of the University Center.

One position is open from UM for the assistant lobbyist, who must be a student at UM. Another assistant lobbyist/^{position}for MSL will be filled by a student at Montana State University, Bozeman.

Assistant lobbyists will aid Mae Nan Ellingson, Missoula, chief lobbyist for the MSL, during the 54th Montana Legislature in Helena in 1977. The lobbyists will promote legislation in the student interest and will provide information to legislators for writing legislation and testimony in committees.
