GEOGRAPHY OF RESOURCES PLANNING PROGRAM
IS WEDNESDAY AT UNIVERSITY OF MONTANA

MISSOULA--

A lecture-discussion program dealing with the geography of resources planning will be presented Wednesday, Dec. 1, at the University of Montana.

Wednesday's program, entitled "Local Issues and Problems in Planning," will be from 7-10 p.m. in room 131 of the UM Science Complex.

Keynote speakers for the lecture portion of the program will be Evan Denney, president of the Missoula Planning Board (MPB) and the Five Valley Parks Association in the Garden City, and John Crowley, MPB planning director.

Following their opening remarks, Denney and Crowley will join three other men in presenting small-group discussions relative to the main program theme.

Wednesday's lecture-discussion program is the ninth in a series of 10 programs being presented fall quarter at UM as part of the forestry course entitled "Perspectives in Resources Planning."
