October 11, 1937

The meeting was called to order by President Peter Murphy, who presided. The minutes of the meeting of October 5 were read and corrected.

Dr. Hesdorffer presented additional facts regarding the purchase of an X-ray and fluoroscopic machine by the Health Service and letters from Ray Whitcomb and Harvey Sannan, Central Board's representatives on the Health Committee, recommending the purchase were read. Carmody moved that Central Board approve the buying of an X-ray and fluoroscopic machine by the Health Service. Shaw seconded. Motion carried.

Central Board advised that Traditions Committee be written a letter criticizing their activities with regard to the lack of preparation for the S.O.S. October 8.

Mr. Briggs moved that the resolution authorizing issuance of auxiliary tickets passed February 2, 1937, be amended to read as follows: "Any married student of the University may obtain a 50¢ auxiliary ticket which will permit his or her spouse, to attend Masquers and Outside Entertainment functions except Community Concerts."

Mr. Briggs presented the matter of incorporation of the student body for the purpose of holding title to student body properties, now held by trustees, and for the purpose of investing student funds available for that purpose. Paulson moved that the President be given power to appoint a committee to continue investigation of incorporation of the student body and to draft a proposed set of by-laws establishing the extent of student control. Shaw seconded. Motion carried. The following committee was appointed: Merritt Warden, Charles Whittinghill, Ray Whitcomb, Mel Singleton, and Peter Murphy (ex officio chairman).

Dr. Shallenberger moved that the letter from Dewey Bowker regarding the student's sponsoring an indoor carnival be referred to the Business Manager for further investigation and for a report at the next meeting. Shaw seconded.
