Special Meeting
November 9, 1936

The special meeting to discuss more fully the different angles of reinstating Montana State University baseball as a major sport was opened by Ray Whitcomb.

The following difficulties of the proposed plan were presented:

1. It would interfere with interscholastic track meet.
2. Chances of getting into the Pacific Coast conference are small.
3. Students feel that they are paying too much for athletics now.
4. The conference as a whole is better equipped than we are.
5. Adding another major sport will harm other activities and sports.
6. Climatic conditions in Missoula are not favorable to baseball.
7. Other organizations which may be handicapped by allotment of their funds to baseball have not had time to present their side of the present proposal.

Professor Briggs made the motion: That we postpone the straw vote so as to allow a more complete set of facts to be presented to the student body. Merrit Warden seconded the motion. It was carried.
