MONTANA POWER COMPANY DONATES THREE  
PORTABLE RADIO TRANSMITTERS TO UM

The Montana Power Company has given three portable radio transmitters to the University of Montana according to Philip J. Hess, UM director of the radio-television studios.

Hess commented that the transmitters, if purchased new, would have cost the University about \$400 apiece, or a total of \$1200.

He said that the portable units would be utilized primarily in giving students enrolled in radio-television studies at the University practical experience in making two-way radio reports of spot news events.

Reports of this kind would generally be used in the news programming of KUFM FM, the University radio station.
