Frank Diliberto, instructor in music in the School of Fine Arts at the University of Montana in Missoula, will be on leave fall quarter to play string bass in the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, conducted by Sir George Solti.

Diliberto is principal bassist of the Missoula Symphony Orchestra. At the University, he teaches double bass and conducts the Montana Little Symphony.

He has played professionally with symphony orchestras in the United States and New Zealand. For the past three summers he has served on the faculty of the International Congress of Strings at the University of Washington, Seattle.

Diliberto holds a bachelor's degree in music education and a master of music degree from Northwestern University, Evanston, Ill.
