UNIVERSITY OF MONTANA NAMES PUBLICATIONS SPECIALIST

Cheryl S. Hutchinson has been appointed Publications Specialist in the department of Information Services at the University of Montana, it was announced by Dr. Darrell J. Inabnit, Executive Vice President of the University.

Miss Hutchinson, a senior Journalism student, will begin her employment after graduation from the University in June. She will be responsible for planning, writing, editing and coordinating mechanical details of publications within the scope of the Information Services program, according to Lawrence D. Stuart, director of the department.

Miss Hutchinson has had newspaper experience with the Missoulian-Sentinel, 1965-66, the Standard-Post in Butte, 1965, and was associate editor of the campus daily, the Montana Kaimin, for three quarters in 1965-66. She was editor of a 28-page promotional supplement appearing last summer in the Standard-Post.

Born in Berkeley, California, Miss Hutchinson transferred to the University of Montana in 1963 after completing her freshman year at San Jose State College. In the past two years she has been recipient of three scholarships, the Thomas J. Hocking Journalism Award, the Theta Sigma Phi Inland Empire Journalism Scholarship and an award from the Lee Newspapers of Montana. She has maintained better than a B average in her major field of study, focusing primarily on news-editorial and advertising courses.

She also has been active on the University campus as a senior resident in Knowles Hall, member of Theta Sigma Phi honorary, publicity director and chairman

of the Student Union Program Council, regional board member representing the University in the Association of College Unions, and a member of the President's committee for the planning of the proposed University Center.

Miss Hutchinson has resided in several foreign countries and graduated from high school in Nouasseur, Morocco. She is the daughter of CWO and Mrs. Norman D. Hutchinson of Weisbaden, Germany. Mr. Hutchinson is stationed at the U.S. Air Force base in Weisbaden.
