Robert C. Uthe, graduate assistant in the University of Montana Department of Music, will present a trombone recital Sunday (May 8) at 3 p.m. in the Recital Hall, according to Dean Charles W. Bolen of the School of Fine Arts.

The recitalist will be accompanied at the piano by Prof. Rudolph Wendt. He will be assisted in the performance of Francis Poulenc's Sonata for Horn, Trumpet and Trombone by Dr. David Whitwell on horn and Roger Letson on trumpet.

The program, open to the public without charge, includes compositions by Henri Dutilleux, Gustav Mahler, Roger Boutry, Marcel Poot and Ludwig van Beethoven.

Uthe is a 1965 graduate of San Diego State College, California. His graduate recital Sunday will partially fulfill requirements for the master of music degree from the Um.
