May 22, 1934

The regular Central Board meeting was called to order by the president, Kenneth Duff.

Two appointments were made by Central Board placing DeLoss Smith on the Outside Entertainment committee and F.C. Schwuch on the Traditions committee.

A section of the minutes from the Athletic Board meeting held May 21st was read concerning the qualified members for football managers as approved by the Athletic Board.

A motion was made, seconded, and passed that Malcolm Stotts be elected football manager for the coming season.

A motion was made, seconded, and passed that Marvin Smoot and Kenneth Spaulding be elected Junior Varsity managers for football.

Al Heller was appointed to investigate the ruling concerning Bruce Winters eligibility for freshman manager-ship in football.

An Outside Entertainment committee meeting was scheduled to be called at 7:15 in Main Hall on May 22nd. An official from the Columbia Broadcasting Company will discuss plans concerning outside entertainment.

The Central Board picnic, planned to be given by the new members for the old members, will not be held.

It was suggested that the Dean of Music, DeLoss Smith, and Barnard Hewitt be present at the next Central Board meeting.

Plans for the Idaho Homecoming game were mentioned. It was suggested that this game be an opportune time for the gathering of alumni of the fraternities and sororities, which would be an aid in stimulating enthusiasm at the time.

A motion was made, seconded, and passed for adjournment.
