November 13, 1934

The meeting was called to order by the president, Kenneth Duff.

An application was received from John Strong, applying for Assistant Managership in fall track.

A letter of thanks, received from President Clapp, was read.

A motion was made, seconded, and passed that a committee of three, P.J. Malone, Business Manager, Kenneth Duff, President, of A.S.U.M., and Ruth Polleys, president of A.W.S., forming the special committee on activity tickets, be appointed, and that they "hear" the various cases which may arise and take necessary action which they think suitable.

Kenneth Duff gave a report concerning the Freshmen letters.

A motion was made, seconded and passed that Central Board approve of Kenneth Duff's procedure in conducting the recent Freshmen elections.

Kenneth Duff will present at the next meeting the procedure for Freshmen elections as suggested in the Constitution so that any necessary amendments may be discussed and approved.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned.
