May 9, 1933

Regular meeting called to order by President. In the absence of the regular secretary Margaret Breen was appointed acting secretary.

Motion made and carried that those elected in past election be accepted.

Professor Elrod; Professor Shallenberger and Kirk Badgley will continue in office, but will formally voted into office by the incoming Central Board. Stanley Hill is a member without a vote, as Kaimin Editor.

Motion made, seconded, and carried that we handle the 5¢ charge for certificate of eligibility on Student University bills.

A plan was presented whereby Central Board would have a representative who would approve contracts, attempt to keep within budget, etc., on Publication Board. This representative would give reports to Central Board, but would not be a member of the board.

Motion made and carried that Professor Hauseman be this representative.

It was suggested that salaries of the business manager and other members of Publication board cut. This was referred to the Budget Committee.

The vote on the referendum for increasing activity fee was 559 in favor, and 159 against. This will be sent to President Clapp.
