## MINUTES OF CENTRAL BOARD

October 11, 1932

The motion was made and passed that Pete Meloy and Kirk Badgley act as a committee to confer with Mr. Merriam for booking certain artists, to look up the budget, and report back to Central Board.

A petition that the appointing of Milton Wertz as Varsity Manager by Coach Oakes and Kirk Badgley be accepted, was approved.

Petitions from Malcolm Stotts and Tome Roe for freshman manager were read, and as Stotts was recommended by Lewandowski and Oakes, he was appointed by Central Board.

It was moved and approved that Mitchell Sheridan take care of the trophies in Butte this year, and that trophies be checked before leaving, and that half of Sheridan's expenses be born by A.S.U.M.

The bill for trophy expenses at Butte game in 1931 was approved.

Kirk Badgley was elected to Central Board.

There being no further business, meeting was adjourned.
