UM FOUNDATION TO HOLD ANNUAL MEETING FRIDAY

Six trustees will be elected to the board of trustees of the University of Montana Foundation at its annual membership meeting this morning (May 27) in the Territorial Room of the Lodge.

Dr. Darrell J. Inabnit, UM executive vice president and director of the UM Foundation, said D. Gordon Rognlein of Kalispell would retire at the end of his term Dec. 31, 1966. By completion of two successive terms as trustee, Rognlein becomes ineligible for reelection under the Foundation's bylaws.

Five other trustees are up for reelection to three-year trustee terms. In addition to the elections, the membership will hear reports on the "State of the University" from President Robert Johns and on the "State of the Foundation" from Dr. Inabnit.

At the trustee meeting to be held after the Foundation luncheon, reports will be heard from new standing committees on property development, aims and programs, financial and research development.

Other reports will be presented on the Foundation's Division of Indian Affairs by Tom Collins, the Foundation's Distinguished Professorships by Dr. Laurence Gale, UM academic vice president, the UM Alumni Association, Inc., by Tom Davis, just elected chairman of the Alumni board, and the music foundation account by Robert T. Pantzer, UM financial vice president.
