MINUTES OF CENTRAL BOARD

October 13, 1931

The meeting was called to order by the president. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. The president reported that some of the stores of the city were willing to cooperate with the University by closing part of the afternoon of the W.S.C. game, but that some refused on the grounds that unless every store closed they lost trade by closing and past experience showed that there were always some that stayed open. A motion was made and carried that a circular letter be sent to the merchants of the city reminding them of their promise to close and thanking them for their cooperation.

Jack Toole and Sterling Stapp, candidates for Varsity Vodvil manager, were voted upon and Jack Toole was elected.

Petitions of Kathleen Harrigan, Betty Kehleher, Leola Stevens, Emma Bravo for assistant Hi-Jinx managers were read. A vote was taken and Emma Bravo and Kathleen Harrigan were elected.

The president reported a loss of about \$5.00 on the last gridgraph.
