Central Board Minutes

May 28, 1929

Meeting called to order by President

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Report of the open shelf committee given by Robert Struckman. Believes that the open shelf has been a big success, so that next year a loan desk with new books will be installed if they can do it. Maybe it will be possible to put such a desk in a room above the student store. If someone else does not take initiative in this regard next fall, Mr. Struckman thinks that Central Board should take charge of it at that time. Decided by Board to let it stand until next year.

Continued discussion of the Minor Sports Recommendation. Moved, seconded and carried that the award be monogrammed in accordance with the sport in which it is given, designation to be decided by the Board of Control.

Moved, seconded and carried that letters be given to the five highest men in scheduled matches. *for riflery*

Moved, seconded and carried that the matter of awards for this year be retroactive for one year only, seven letters being given, two in golf and five in riflery.
