MINUTES OF CENTRAL BOARD

October 15, 1929

Meeting called to order by President

Minutes of previous meeting read and corrected.

Hi Jinx Committee composed of Lloyd Callison, James Garlington, Russell Smith, Carl Rankin, and Frank Curtis as submitted by Silent Sentinel, was read and approved.

The following men were appointed to serve on the Constitutional Committee: Steiner Larson, Russell Smith, and Carl McFarland.

Letter from the National Student Federation soliciting our membership was read by the President. Decided that we should write for further information.

Discussion concerning Butte game. An effort will be made to secure approximate number of persons going to Butte.

Motion made and carried that Russell Smith be appointed financial manager of Hi Jinx, and be given  $2\frac{1}{2}\%$  of net receipts as compensation; assistant managers to be called for by petition.
