PARADE, GAME HIGHLIGHT UM HOMECOMING SATURDAY

Homecoming Weekend at the University of Montana will be in full swing Saturday, with the traditional parade, the football game, and class reunions headlining the agenda.

Homecoming king and queen Dave Fred, Marysville, and Cathie Nelson, Missoula, will ride in the parade and reign over other festivities. Fred is a senior in business administration, and Nelson is a junior majoring in philosophy and political science/history.

The parade will form at 10 a.m. at Circle Square and proceed by way of Higgins Avenue to the campus.
