"ENRICO IV" OPENS OCTOBER 31

"Enrico IV" by Luigi Pirandello will open Wednesday, Oct. 31, at the Great Western Stage in Main Hall at the University of Montana. The play will run from Oct. 31 through Nov. 3 and Nov. 7 through 10. Curtain is at 8 p.m.

The play is the Department of Drama/Dance entry in the American College
Theatre Festival. It is directed by Randy Bolton, head of the department's
actor training program.

Bolton says "Enrico IV" deals with the Marchioness Spina, her daughter, her lover, and a psychiatrist as they attempt to quell the grandiose delusions (or are they delusions?) of the Marchioness's friend who is convinced that he is Emperor Henry IV.

"The great modern Italian playwright considered this his finest play,"
Bolton said. "In it he blurs the boundaries of sanity and madness, of fantasy
and reality, to create an unforgettably startling evening of theatre."

Tickets for "Enrico IV" are \$3.50 for the public and \$2.50 for students and senior citizens. Season tickets are available for the Great Western Stage 1979-80 season. For tickets and reservations call 243-4581 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays and from noon to 6 p.m. Saturdays.
