EIGHT SHOWS SCHEDULED FOR 1979-80 GREAT WESTERN STAGE SEASON

Three major productions and five fringe productions are scheduled by the Department of Drama/Dance at the University of Montana for the Great Western Stage 1979-80 season.

The Great Western Stage is located on the second floor of Main Hall on campus. Curtain time for all productions is 8 p.m.

The major productions are:

"Enrico IV," Oct. 31-Nov. 3; Nov. 7-10; Euripides' "Electra," March 4-8, and "The Shadow Box," April 30-May 3; May 7-10.

Fringe productions for fall quarter are:

Three one-act plays directed by graduate students, Nov. 1-17, and an Evening of Beckett, Nov. 29 and 30 and Dec. 1.

The student-directed plays are "The Sandcastle," "Ludlow Fair," and "The Ruffian on the Stair."

The Beckett plays are two one-acts, "Krapp's Last Tape" and "Not I."

Season tickets are available at \$16 for the general public and \$12 for students and senior citizens. Seating is limited and reservations are required. For reservations on information, call 243-4581 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays and from noon to 6 p.m. Saturdays.
