CENTRAL BOARD MINUTES
1927 - 1928

Central Board

Sept. 19, 1927

Meeting called to order by President Mike Thomas.

Minutes read and approved.

Convention report was given by Mike Thomas who offered valuable suggestions for frosh week, relations of student and faculty, and comparison of student fees, time rules and etc.

In absence of a yell leader the president is to make an appointment with the approval of Central board. Fred Ironsides was named as first choice and Nelson Fritz second. Motion was made that Mike Thomas should appoint Fred Ironsides. Motion carried.

A.S.U.M. program for the frosh to be given Thursday afternoon. All officers to be present for introduction.

S.O.S. to be given Thursday nite with Emmerson Stone in charge.

A.S.U.M. mixer scheduled for Saturday nite at the gym. Lapel place card with name to be used for convenience. Sheridans seven piece orchestra to furnish the music. Effort to be made to keep the crowd pushed back.

Meeting adjourned upon motion.

Meeting called to order by President Mike Thomas.

Minutes read and approved.

Sentinel staff made a request for a new typewriter as they are denied the use of those in the shack. Books showed the Sentinel to have a cash balance of \$850, no bonuses being paid. Motion was made authorizing Doug Thomas to investigate costs and submit prices at next meeting of the board. Motion carried.

Jimmie Marrow to be instructed to order sweater for the Yell King.

Homecoming committee ask permission to sell tags to finance the day. The tags to be sold for fifty cents and admit wearer to the game in the morning and mixer at nite. Motion made to grant permission. Motion carried.

Central board requested to look after decorations for the campus with the suggestion that they be similiar to those used for the interscholastic meet. Thomas to appoint a committee to investigat feasibility and expense and report for next meeting.

Motion made that Dante Hanson receive a bonus of one month salary or \$25 for splendid management of Kaimin last year. Motion carried. Thomas to enclose a letter of appreciation in behalf of Central Board.

Question of Sentinel Staff Bonus was discussed. Report to be submitted next meeting or profit and debt of the Sentinel.

Nelson Fritz reported S.O.S. the Thursday before Homecoming. Athletes to be displayed on platform by the bonfire. Dr. Elrod suggested that the wood be brought for the fire rather than sent the frosh after it.

Advertising proportion was offered 500 inches at 50¢ could be contracted for. Regular charge is made at 70¢ an inch. Motion made and carried that the 500 inch be contracted for. A quota to be placed on each organization and contract to be drawn according to last year. Motion made that Kirk Badgley investigate conditions and make the contract. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned.
