October 18, 1927

Meeting opened by the President Mike Thomas.

Minutes read and approved.

Discussed the financial aspect of sending the band to Butte. Motion made seconded and carried that discision in regard to cash of trip to Butte for the band be left to the executive committee of the band.

A bill from Swearinger for five dollars to pay for the loss of the observatory burned by the frosh for the bohfire was discussed. Action to be deferred until President Clapp has been interviewed.

Loss of twenty five dollars was reported on the game returns from W.S.C. quarter by quarter returns to be sent from Idaho and announced at the frosh game.

Wallace Blue was elected Varsity Basketball mangaer for this year. William Crawford was appointed as his assistant. Jack Baker was elected manager of the frosh team.

Matter of reserved seats for basket ball was discussed. The plan was to reserve a section down stairs for twenty five cents a seat. The money would hekp make up the defecit of the athletic fun. Action postponed for further consideration.

Nelson Fritz appointed to see about band music. To find out ~~about~~ what schools songs the band has and to make arrangements to get the others.

Reported robbery of the A.U.M. store Sunday nite. A sack of money belonging to the M. Club are indebted to McCollum for \$200 plus their bills. Concessions on Butte Special to be granted M. club to help pay off indebetedness.

Meeting adjourned.
