## ART PROGRAM FOR YOUTHS BEGINS

MISSOULA--

Missoula area youths ages three through high school are invited to attend the Saturday morning Arts Enrichment program at the University of Montana, beginning Jan. 19 in room 101 of the Fine Arts building. The program, sponsored by the UM art department, will continue for seven weeks, 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. each Saturday.

The program will attempt to bring the youths in contact with the arts through an individualized, creative approach. Each student will have the opportunity to select his area of interest in activities such as drawing and painting, sculpture, photography, creative movement, writing and music composition.

Cost for the program, which is under the direction of Associate Professor Dick Reinholtz, is 89¢ per Saturday.
