VICE PRESIDENT HUMPHREY IS TO
"MEET THE STUDENTS" AT UM

Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey will highlight his visit to Missoula Thursday (Sept. 29) with a "Meet the Students" panel discussion on the University of Montana campus.

Mr. Humphrey is expected to appear before assembled students and faculty in the University theatre shortly after 2:00 p.m. He will respond for approximately half an hour, to questions fired at him by four student panelists and a student moderator.

He also will speak and mingle with students, faculty and townspeople outside the theatre. Persons for whom there are no seats in the theatre, will be able to listen outdoors to the "Meet the Students" session over a specially designed public address system.

The panel discussion will be video taped for future telecasting purposes, hence the selection of the University theatre.

The student moderator is Thomas W. Behan, speech senior from Anchorage, Alaska, and president of the Associated Students. He will introduce the four panelists and Dr. Laurence E. Gale, UM academic vice president, who is to introduce Mr. Humphrey.

The four panelists are Miss Sharon J. Browning, foreign language junior from Great Falls; Lee H. Simmons, law freshman from Red Lodge; Gregory L. Ulmer, history and English senior from Miles City; and Jean C. Lachkar, foreign language and literature junior from Argenteuil, France, via Miles City.

Mr. Humphrey, 55, is a native of South Dakota. The twice-mayor of Minneapolis and former United States Senator from Minnesota is married to Muriel Buck, also a South Dakotan. The Humphreys have four children and four grandchildren.

He holds a degree from the Denver College of Pharmacy, a B.A. from the University of Minnesota and a M.A. from Louisiana State University. In addition to numerous honorary and governmental consulting positions, Mr. Humphrey is President of the United States

Senate and a member of the Cabinet and the National Security Council. He is chairman of the National Aeronautics and Space Council.

When Mr. Humphrey's airplane arrives at the Missoula Airport at approximately 1 p.m. he will speak on behalf of Democratic candidates, before travelling to the University for his non-political appearance. After meeting the student panel and greeting persons outside the theater, Mr. Humphrey will travel to the Northern Forest Fire Laboratory west of Missoula to tour the facility and speak briefly on its work.
