May 18, 1926

Meeting called to order by president.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Mr. Hoelscher was present. The finances of the band were taken up with him. A motion was made and seconded that in the event of expenditure over \$10.00, Mr. Hoelscher should first obtain requisition from K. Badgley. Motion carried.

The matter of A. W. S. representative on Central Board was discussed. No conclusion reached.

The introductory booklet for Freshmen was discussed. Motion made and seconded that it be made a regular activity of A.S.U.M. officers. Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded that a committee of the president and two others should investigate recommendations regarding participation in State Oratorical Association to report at next meeting. Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded that Secretary be instructed to inform Joseph Owens of National Collegiate World Court Conference that we already belong to a similar body. Motion carried.

It was recommended that president Smith attend Pacific Coast Presidents' Conference as our official delegate.

Those present: Smith, Thomas, Reeder, Badgley, Miller, Elrod, Maddock, Eminger.

The controversy about the name Grizzlie was again taken up.

Meeting adjourned.
