October 12, 1926

Meeting opened by president.

Minutes read and approved.

Report of committee for investigation of enlarging Traditions Committee. Recommended that the committee be composed of fifteen members. A motion to this effect was made, seconded and carried. The personnel of this committee is recommended to be the following: Sanford, chairman, Sweetman, Miller, Art Burns, Fred Ironsides, Steiner Larson, Andy Cogswell, Bob Worden, A. Desmond, Henry Miller, Eloise Vinal, Margaret Maddock, Bria Graham, Eddie Reeder, Burt Smith, ex-officio

Mr. Click presented a request that Central Board underwrite the expenses for equipment of the Little Theatre. *to the Little Theatre* Motion to that effect made, seconded and carried.

Burt Smith reported that President Clapp had consented to allow a student convocation before the Aggie game in Butte. The hour agreed upon is on Tuesday, October 19, at 2:00 o'clock. Program to be mostly musical with short talks to rouse interest in the Aggie game in Butte. This report accepted; final program to be arranged by Traditions Committee.

It was moved and seconded that the recommendation of Stewart and Milburn regarding football managers be accepted. Motion carried. The following is the recommendation: That, due to the resignation of Otto Bessey, the two present football managers, McFarland and Angland, be eligible for Varsity manager next year; that for this season, Henry McFarland be assigned position of assistant Varsity manager and that Angland be made Frost manager; that their present duties have no bearing on the selection of either man for varsity manager; and that because both men are sophmores, the designation of which shall be varsity manager next year, be left until the end of the present season, and that the selection shall rest upon the services and merits of the men.

The men's smoker again discussed. Committee appointed to investigate possibilities: Chairman, Milton Brown, Eddie Reeder, Dr. Elrod.

Matter of sending a Kaimin representative to Butte to cover game brought up for discussion. It was moved and seconded that Central Board approved this action on the part of the Kaimin, expenses to be paid from fund of Kaimin. Motion carried.

A motion was made and seconded that the following organization be exempted from payment of their page in the Sentinel:- Central Board, Band, Bear Paws, Tannans, Silent Sentinel, Kaimin, M. Club, Penetratia, the four classes and Debate. Motion carried.

A motion made, seconded, and carried that Cantral Board receive a report about this year's Sentinel at the next regular meeting.

Discussion of expenses of last years Sentinel.
