OF BIG SKY BB TOURNAMENT TICKETS

Now that the University of Montana Grizzly basketball team has qualified for its third straight Big Sky Conference basketball tournament, the UM Field House Ticket Office will begin selling tournament tickets Monday, Feb. 25. The ticket office is open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.

The Big Sky tournament will be held in Ogden, Utah, hosted by the Weber State Wildcats for the second consecutive season. Weber State won the right to host the tourney by placing first in the regular season.
