Central Board

May 26, 1925

Meeting called to order by president Oscar Dalberg.

Minutes of the last meeting were dispensed with.

Letter was read by the president from Mr. Atkinson in which nine men were recommended to receive band medals. Motion was made and seconded that the letter be turned over to Burt Smith and that the medals be ordered. Motion carried.

Question of baseball game with Bozeman was brought up and report of Athletic Board given on the subject. There was to be no game of baseball played with Bozeman.

Debate medals were to be given out at the same time the band medals were.

Report was given by Sanford on the May Fete parade. A.W.S. was to stand all expense.

Revising of constitution was taken up. A committee was to be appointed at a later date to have charge of this. A suggestion was made that the committee have the revision ready by a week from Thursday or June 4.

A motion was made that the president be authorized to appoint a committee of five, to draw up a constitution to be placed before the student body for approval. Motion seconded and carried.

A suggestion was made that a list of men to receive M blankets be handed in for approval.

A banquet for the outgoing members of A.S.U.M. was discussed. Buleah Gagnon was placed in charge of the banquet. It was decided to have the banquet June 2nd at the Palace Hotel at 6 o'clock. A.S.U.M. meeting to be held there.

Report from the Athletic Board was given.

Motion made and seconded that Central Board allow the Athletic Board to overdraw their account to take care of deficit. The overdraft to be returned next fall. Motion carried.

Reverse fund brought up and explained by Mr. Elrod. Mr. Elrod made the recommendation that A.S.U.M. invest \$2,000 worth of bonds for the Alumni Challenge Athletic Field to be purchased from the sinking funds. In this way paying ourselves interest and making money. Motion made and seconded that we accept Mr. Elrod's recommendation. Motion carried.

Bob Warden asked for aid for the 1926 Sentinel. Motion made and seconded that the 1926 Sentinel be allowed to overdraw their account to take care of miscellaneous expenses for this year, 1925. Motion carried.

Those present were Dalberg, Elrod, Warden, Sanford, Porter, Gagnon, Smith, Bagley, Rothwell.

Meeting adjourned.
