Approximately 15 percent of the undergraduates at the University of Montana made the Deans' List for winter quarter. Of the 1,052 students on the list, 395, or about six percent of the student body, had a straight-A grade-point average of 4.00.

To place on the list, a student must have earned a grade-point average of at least B+ (3.50) and must have taken at least 80 percent of his credits on the regular letter-grade system (A, B, C, D, F). Students must meet both requirements; and those who take more than 20 percent of their credits on the pass-fail system do not qualify regardless of their grade point average.

The Deans' List released by the University is compiled from computer printouts and does not include the names of students who failed to designate their hometowns when they filled out registration forms.
