## MONTANA STRING QUARTET TO GO ON TOUR

The Montana String Quartet, resident ensemble at the University of Montana, will tour to Helena and Bozeman, April 8 and 9, to give free public performances.

The group will perform in the Plymouth Congregational Church, Helena, April 8 at 8 p.m. and in the Recital Hall of the Montana State University Music Building, Bozeman, April 9 at 8 p.m.

The tour is sponsored by the UM music department and the Helena public schools. In Helena, on April 8, the group will also conduct workshops for music students in both public high schools.

The Montana String Quartet consists of Walter Olivares, violin, UM assistant professor of music; Kurt Sprenger, violin, UM graduate student in music; Bernard McWilliams, viola, UM associate professor of music; and Fern Glass, cello, UM assistant professor of music.

Flutist Debra Shorrock, UM assistant professor of music, will accompany the group on tour.
