PERRY WILL PRESENT
ORGAN PROGRAM AT U

Organist Laurence Perry will perform music ranging from the classical to the contemporary in a free faculty recital Sunday (Oct 30) at 8:15 p.m. in the University of Montana Recital Hall.

The first half of the program is comprised of Prelude and Fuge in C Major by Georg Bohm, Suite for a Musical Clock by Franz Joseph Haydn, and two compositions by J. S. Bach.

The second part of the recital features works by Sigfrid Karg-Elert, Walter Piston, Aaron Copland, Virgil Thomson and Jean Langlais.

The recitalist, who heads the UM Music Department, has been a member of the faculty since 1959. After earning two degrees at Cornell College, he took a master's degree in organ at Syracuse University and did further graduate work at Indiana University. He is a member of the American Guild of Organists and other professional societies and has served as an officer of the **UM** chapter of Pi Kappa Lambda national music honorary.
