GRIZZLY TRACKSTERS HOST MSU
IN FINAL HOME MEET OF 1980 SEASON

MISSOULA--

Coach Marshall Clark's 1980 University of Montana men's track team will have its final home meet of the season Saturday, April 26, when UM hosts Montana State University in a dual contest. The meet begins at 1 p.m.

Most of the Grizzly track team was idle last weekend; however, Clark took a handful of athletes to the Mt. Sac Relays in Walnut, Calif.

Junior Dave Gordon (Olympia, Wash.) had an excellent trip, overcoming 96-degree weather to place first in the 10,000 meters. His time was 29:53.4. Teammate Tom Raunig was third in 30:11.4.

Tim Fox won his heat in the high hurdles in 14.78, and was fourth in the intermediate hurdles in 52.73. Dale Giem was third in the same intermediate race in 52.21.

Guy Rogers ran a personal best in the 800 in a time of 1:50.8. Larry Weber also ran a PR, clocking 3:49 in the 1500 meters. He placed fourth in the race.

"It was a very good effort by several of our kids considering the drive down and the weather," said Clark. "I thought it was about as good as we could have done considering the conditions."

Clark said he expected a very close meet with the Bobcats Saturday. UM has not lost a dual meet to MSU since 1966.

"We'll have to win both relays (1600M and 400M) to win," said Clark. "We'll also have to double a lot of kids. Montana State is a very good team, especially in the field events."

Tickets are \$2 for adults and \$1 for students. UM students with winter-spring sports passes get in free.
